Local Government Elections Task Force:

The Council of the Town of View Royal discussed this matter at its meeting on February 16, 2010. Their comments were as follows:

- There should be a maximum limit (i.e. a "cap") set for the monetary value of donations received by each candidate from individuals, corporations and organizations.
- There should be a cap set for how much each candidate can spend on their election campaign.
- There should be new conflict of interest guidelines for donations received.
- The 3-year election cycle should be maintained.
- There should be clarification as to the consequences of any violations of election rules.
